GENERAL INFORMATION

- * Strings del Rio, a summer orchestra day camp will be held June 3rd-7th, 2019, in Yuma, AZ, at Cibola High School, 4100 W. 20th Street from 9:00 a.m. - 12:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. On Friday there will be a Lunch Party to end the week for all camp students, followed by a performance in the auditorium at 1:00 p.m., to which parents are invited to attend.
- * We will use the parking lots on the South part of the campus which enters from 20th Street. Enter through the entrance doors to the cafeteria for registration and daily drop-off and pick-up.
- * Camp T-shirt, pencil, camp bag, orchestra music and a mid-morning snack will be provided.
- * Anyone under 18 wishes to participate in the “government provided breakfast” which is served in the cafeteria, they may arrive at 8:30 and participate prior to camp beginning at 9:00 a.m. Campers under 14 will need a parent with them.
- * There will be a lock in activity on Thursday evening more information to come.
- * Daily fun such as crazy hair day will take place. Campers will be told about which activity and what will happen each day on the 1st day of camp.
- * Scholarships for camp are available on a first come first served basis. Please email YumaOrchestraAssociation@gmail.com for more information.

REGISTRATION

- * Camp tuition includes camp t-shirt, pencil, bag, class music, and mid-morning snacks.
- * The total cost is \$125.00, with a \$25.00 discount if registered by May 1, 2019 ; \$50.00 of said total is non-refundable. All 3 forms must be completed and returned with payment.
- * Registration begins April 1, 2019. Make checks payable to the Yuma Orchestra Association.
- * If you are handicapped and desire special accommodations please advise us when you register.

DISCOUNTS

- * Students paying the fee *in full* by May 1, 2019, will pay the early fee of \$ 100.00

REFUNDS

- * Refunds before June 1, 2019 will not include the \$50.00 deposit.. *No refunds will be given out after the camp begins.*

PAYMENT PLANS

- * Students may make payments for tuition, but tuition must be paid in full on the first day of camp.

HEALTH SERVICES

- * The camp is less than three miles from a Regional Medical Center and two miles from an Urgent Care facility or EMT/Firehouse.
- * Students of all ages must complete and turn in the Medical Information and Waiver forms to the camp director.

ORCHESTRA PLACEMENT

- * Students will confer with private/orchestra teacher (after studying “*Camper Eligibility*” page) for placement in camp orchestra level.
- * Conductors have the right to switch students to another orchestra level later in the week in order to place a student in the best situation for their personal needs.
