## GENERAL INFORMATION

- \* Strings del Rio, a summer orchestra day camp will be held June 4<sup>th</sup>-8th, 2018, in Yuma, AZ, at Cibola High School, 4100 W. 20<sup>th</sup> Street from 9;00 a.m. 12:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. On Friday there will be a Lunch Party to end the week, followed by performances in the auditorium at 1:00 p.m., to which parents are invited to attend. This day will end at 2:00 p.m.
- \* We will use the parking lots on the South part of the campus which enters from 20<sup>th</sup> Street. Enter through the entrance doors to the cafeteria for registration and daily dropoff and pick-up.
- \* Classes provided will be:
  - ^ Orchestra rehearsal for violins, violas, celli, and/or double string basses.
  - ^ Sectionals (small group lessons over difficult areas of the orchestra music.)
  - ^ Rhythms and Sight Reading
  - ^ Theory (theory games and challenges)
  - ^ Music History
- \* Camp T-shirt, pencil, camp bag, orchestra music and a mid-morning snack will be provided.
- \* Anyone under 18 wishes to participate in the "government provided breakfast" which Is served in the cafeteria, they may arrive at 8:30 and participate prior to camp beginning at 9:00 a.m. Campers under 14 will need a parent with them.
- \* Any string player who can meet the criteria of one of the orchestra levels (*read"Camper Eligibility"*) is welcome. Students under 18 years of age needing hotel accommodations must be accompanied by a chaperone after camp hours.
- There will be a lock in activity on Thursday evening more information to come
- Daily fun such as crazy hair day will happen daily. Campers will be told about activity and what day on the 1<sup>st</sup> day.

## **REGISTRATION**

- \* Camp tuition includes camp t-shirt, pencil, bag, class music, and mid-morning snacks.
- \* The total cost is \$125.00, with a \$25.00 discount if registered by May 1, 2018; \$50.00 of said total is non-refundable. All 3 forms must be completed and returned with Payment.
