

Strings Del Rio
2019 Camper Eligibility

Any string player who fit somewhere in the following criteria are eligible to participate in Strings Del Rio. Upon recommendation of orchestra/private teacher, students will be divided into four levels of playing expertise. Conductors have the right to make class changes during the week if the change will enhance the student's success at camp.

Level 1 Orchestra should be able to:

Recognize notes on the music staff
Play music written with whole, dotted half, half, and quarter notes
Play a one octave scale G, D, A and arpeggio
Three fingers on the strings

Level 2 Orchestra should be able to:

Be proficient in the eligibility requirements for Level 1 Orchestra
Read and be proficient in playing notes that would include a 1 octave G, D, A scale and arpeggio

Level 3 Orchestra should be able to :

Be proficient in the eligibility requirements for level 1 & 2 Orchestra
Play a G, D, and A 2-octave scale, C scale, F, and arpeggio
Play G and D minor
Basses are expected to play the above scales and arpeggios 1 octave
Read music

Level 4 Orchestra students should be able to:

Be proficient in the eligibility requirements for level 1, 2, & 3 Orchestras
Play a 2 octave C, G, D, A, F, B flat, E flat major scales, g, d, a, minor scales, and arpeggios
Play in the key of C
Basses are expected to play the above scales and arpeggios 1 octave

All students will participate in a Summer Camp concert on Friday.
