**Directions to Cibola High School:**

Exit Interstate 8 at 16<sup>th</sup> Street. Drive West on 16<sup>th</sup> Street for 2 miles. Turn South on Avenue C and go 2 city blocks. Turn West on 20<sup>th</sup> Street and turn into the first gate on the right into the parking lot. Enter the large building on the North of the campus and enter through the double glass doors into the “Cafeteria”.

**Chair Placement:**

Each camper should carefully choose (with the recommendation of private/orchestra teacher) the orchestra in which they feel confident they can be a strong player. The conductor can move a camper to a different orchestra level as they believe it will best benefit the player. Chair placement will be left up to the conductor as well.
